Questions | Choose which questions the group wants to respond to!

1. How do the people first respond to the Book of the Law of Moses (Ch. 8:3,5,6,9)? Why do you think they responded this way? How important was the reading of God's word in your own personal rebuilding?
2. Read Leviticus 23:34-43. What is the link between the Exodus from Egypt and their return from exile? How did this add to the festive spirit? What acts of God do you celebrate regularly with joy? How can we celebrate each other's' wins better?
3. In chapter 9 the people gather again. What is the occasion for this gathering? How do they prepare?
4. When you were growing up, what did "confession" mean to you? What was required? How do you show sincerity in your confession and repentance of sin today? Have you done that lately? Have you heard from God, seen the brokenness around you and realized you've been part of the problem?
5. Do you write down any of your prayers? Why? Have you gone back and re-read them later?
6. How can you go "all in" in your relationships? In your business? In your giving? Have you been baptized? Share a story about an "all in" moment or time in your life.
